


Change in Georgia 125% Poverty Population 1990-2000

Note 1: Income level is only one factor in determining client eligibility, set at or below 125% of the poverty level. Other factors may include: asset ceilings, alien status, citizenship, conflict of interest, recipient resources, or unique client circumstances that allow recipients to use their discretion in providing services. Note 2: Some extreme changes may be due to the realignment and splitting of Census Tracts by the Bureau of Census between the 1990 and 2000 censuses.
