


ALAS Closed Cases 1996-2000 and Income-Eligible Persons 1990 - Clayton County



Note 1: Income level is only one factor in determining client eligibility, set at or below 125% of the poverty level. Other factors may include: asset ceilings, alien status, citizenship, conflict of interest, recipient resources, or unique client circumstances that allow recipients to use their discretion in providing services.

Note 2: Dots are placed randomly within Census Block Group.
